Expenses - includes costs for program services, management costs and fundraising costs.

Expense ratio - Expenses divided by revenue. Ratios of more than 100 percent indicate that expenses exceed revenue.

Excess - the excess of revenues over expenses
Total compensation - includes salary, contributions to benefit plans and other allowances.
NA - Not available. NM - Not meaningful.
